### **Aims of the Stichting**

The Stichting, or Foundation is founded upon and continues the activities of the association "Quartier Général International du Mouvement Soufi"; the objectives of which were: "*the administration, coordination and development of the Sufi Movement*". The Foundation is for the dissemination of the Sufi message brought to the Western World by Pir-o-Murshid, Hazrat Inayat Khan. It springs from the following Sufi thoughts:

1. There is one God, the Eternal, the Only Being; none else exists save God.

2. There is only one Master, the Guiding Spirit of all souls, who constantly leads all followers towards the light.
3. There is one Holy Book, the sacred manuscript of nature, which can enlighten the reader.
4. There is one Religion, the unswerving progress in the right direction towards the ideal, which fulfils the life's purpose of every soul.
5. There is one Law, the Law of reciprocity, which can be observed by a selfless conscience together with a sense of awakened justice.
6. There is one Brotherhood, the human Brotherhood and Sisterhood, which unites the children of earth indiscriminately in the fatherhood of God.
7. There is one Moral Principle, the love which springs forth from self-denial, and blooms in deeds of beneficence.
8. There is one Object of Praise, the beauty which uplifts the heart of its worshipper through all aspects from the seen to the unseen.
9. There is one Truth, the true knowledge of our being within and without, which is the essence of all wisdom.
10. There is one Path, the annihilation of the false ego in the real, which raises the mortal to immortality and in which resides all perfection.

The Objective of the Stichting, is to achieve the goal of spreading the Sufi Message of Pir-o-Murshid Hazrat Inayat Khan, as stated below:

1. to realise and spread the knowledge of unity, the religion of love and wisdom, so that the bias of faiths and beliefs may of itself fall away, the human heart may overflow with love, and all hatred caused by the distinctions and differences may be rooted out;
2. to discover the light and power latent in the human being, the secret of all religion, the power of mysticism, and the essence of philosophy, without interfering with customs or beliefs;
3. to help bring the world's two opposite poles, East and West, to be closer together by the interchange of thoughts and ideals, that the universal brotherhood and sisterhood may form of itself, and people may meet beyond the narrow national and racial boundaries.

In order to achieve the above objectives the following are applied to all activities:

1. The Foundation refrains from any interference in politics.

2. The object of the Foundation is not to make profits. However, with a view to maintaining and managing its assets, the Foundation may set up companies and/or institutions and participate in their capital.

3. The monetary means of the Foundation consist of:

- A. donations and periodic contributions;
- B. property acquired by testamentary succession and specific legacies;
- C. the income from assets of the Foundation;
- D. proceeds of the activities (also) organised by the Foundation;
- E. results of fund raising and actions; and
- F. all other income.

### **Structure of the Stichting**

The Stichting is led spiritually (Head of the Inner School), strategically and managerially by the General Representative and is supported by the following members of the Board for managerial and administrative functions:

- The Executive Supervisor;
- The Treasurer;
- The General Secretary;
- The Executive Supervisor Emeritus;
- The General Member

The Foundation is comprised of and supports for the achievement of its stated aims and objectives the following five principal activities:

- the initiatic school for inner realisation ('Inner School'): the Sufi Order;
- the religious activity: the Universal Worship;
- the social activity: the World Brother and Sisterhood;
- the healing activity: the Spiritual Healing; and
- the activity of symbolical inner realisation comprised of: the Zirat and the Element Ritual.

The Secretaries for these Activities are all members of the Board.

All appointments are made by the General Representative; with the exception of this role for which there is a separate process as identified in the Stichting Articles.

### **Remuneration Policy**

The remuneration policy for members of the Stichting is identified at Article 6(18) of the Stichting: *"Members of the Board will not receive an attendance fee. They are entitled however to compensation of costs incurred by them in the exercise of their functions. Furthermore, the General Representative receives a stipend to be determined by the Executive Supervisor and the Treasurer, which may be adjusted to reflect the current economic circumstances 'in any given year'.*

### **Policy Plan: main components**

1. Development and revision of processes and procedures for the Stichting International Sufi Movement.
2. Development of operational, tactical and strategic plans for the International Sufi Movement for the achievement of aims and objectives identified in the Articles and this document.
3. Point (2) to be supported and enabled by the strategies of the *Activities* of the International Sufi Movement (Stichting).
4. Development of the website and social media profiles for the dissemination of the Message.
5. Development of international projects to build upon the work established in recent years.
